Dear Armada Area School Families,

In an effort to keep our families informed, we had two middle school students, nine elementary students, one pre-K student, and four staff members test positive for COVID-19 over the past three weeks. In addition to those who have contracted COVID-19, 14 pre-K students and 3 elementary siblings had to quarantine ten days due to these cases. We are averaging 1.6 student cases of COVID-19 per school day in the district as 109 students (out of 1,877 or 5.8%) have tested positive for COVID-19 during our 68 school days. Also, we have had 32 district staff members test positive for COVID-19 during the school year.

On another note, due to recent events, the district is going to begin our strategic planning process sooner than later. Our first meeting will be on Tuesday, December 21st from 5:00 – 6:30 pm at the AHS auditorium. The topic for our first meeting will be School Safety. All parents, students, staff, and community members are welcome to attend all of our strategic planning meetings. We will provide other strategic planning meeting dates after we return from winter break.
