The Magic of Science

In ancient times magicians wielded tremendous power in society. Today, of course, we realize that the mysterious world of magic is truly the world of science. All magic is comprised of illusions mostly based on scientific principles. In this program we look behind the "magic" to find basic chemistry, light, magnetism, optical illusions, physics, and mathematics. Come with us on a journey of exploration into the science behind the magic.

The Earth Dome

The Earth Balloon uses high altitude, and highly detailed NASA photography printed on the surface of a giant globe to enable participants to view our planet as though from outer space. This 22 feet in diameter and 19 foot in height globe is constructed of 24 panels of fire resistant dacron material, each representing a different time zone. Participants learn geography, climatology and geology in a truly unforgettable day.

Crime Scene Science

This program is devoted to introducing participants to the exciting field of the science behind solving crimes. In the process you child will be exposed to important aspects of critical thinking essential not only in the Scientific Method, but in all forms of Problem Solving. We show the participants that this field actually draws from all forms of science. Introduced also are basic rules of observation and creative thinking, as laid out many years ago by the famous fictional detective Sherlock Holmes. Participants will be asked to help solve the crime of "The Great Cat Capper!" Personal Water Craft (PWC) are a fun and healthful recreation for people of all ages. This class will teach you many things and to become a responsible driver. This is a mandatory class for any person 12 to 13 years of age with restrictions. 14 and older: If a person is born after December 31, 1978 you may operate a PWC only if he or she has obtained a Safety Certificate. Anyone born after December 31, 1978 or earlier may operate a PWC without restrictions. After successfully completing this class you will be certified in (PWC) Safety. There is 6 1/2 hours of information and techniques that are covered. There is also a question and answer time.
