We are pleased to present you with the Annual Education Report (AER) which provides key information on the 2010-2011 educational progress for Armada High School. The AER addresses the complex reporting information required by federal and state laws. The school's report contains information about student assessment, Adequate Yearly Progress (AYP) and teacher quality. The AER is available for your review on the website or you may receive a copy from the main office at Armada High School.

For 2010-2011, Armada High School made Adequate Yearly Progress (AYP) in English language arts and mathematics. While we are pleased to have reached this important goal, we are continuously working to improve. We appreciate the continued support of parents, staff and our community in this effort.

State law requires that we also report additional information.

1. Students are assigned to Armada High School based on residency or acceptance through schools of choice.
2. Armada High School recently completed its Quality Assurance Review under the NCA school improvement process. We are happy to report we were fully accredited. We continue to work on improving the achievement of our students.
3. Our Core curriculum is accessible on our website under the curriculum guide link.
4. Our students have an average score of 19.2 on the ACT exam.
5. Approximately 63% of our parents participate in our parent-teacher conferences. This includes the parents of approximately 400 students.

6. Other items of interest:

- a. We currently have seven students who are dual-enrolled at Macomb Community College and Armada High School.
- b. We offer seven AP level courses at Armada High School: Biology, Art Portfolio, English, World History, Computer Science, Calculus, and US History.
- c. In the 2010-2011 school year, 107 students took an AP level course.
- d. In the 2010-2011 school year, 47 students received a score sufficient to qualify for advanced credit at the college they are attending.

We are excited about the success of our students over the past year, and look forward to another successful year. It is the combined efforts of our parents, students and staff that we continue to seek expanded opportunities for our students.
