

SCHOLARSHIP OPPORTUNITIES--2010

All deadlines are firm. Scholarship applications must be complete when submitted. All applications that need official transcripts must be returned to the counseling office for mailing. Students should request recommendation letters well in advance of the deadlines. Be sure to check All the college financial aid websites for college specific opportunities as well as www.fastweb.com for other opportunities. Ms. Kowitz is usually in the office daily until 3:30 pm if you have questions or paperwork to drop off. **Remember, scholarships may be turned in before the due date.**

4 County Foundation Scholarships—All are due March 26 in the counseling office or April 1 to the 4-County office in Almont. Applications are available in the counseling office or online at www.4ccf.org

- **Cryderman-Hebblewhite Agricultural Fund**—College or vocational students with a declared major related to Agriculture, Food Production, or Veterinary Medicine.
- **William and Betty Morrison Memorial Scholarship**—Any senior can apply. Must be attending a post high school educational program
- **Russell W. Ligon**—Must be majoring in engineering or computer science, recommendations, essay questions, resume needed
- **George Souten**—Must be majoring in a performing art, vocal or instrumental music
- **Vera Souten**—Must be majoring in any medical field other than pre-med to become a physician.
- **Youth Advisory—Any senior can apply.**

AHS Common Scholarship Application—This is the umbrella scholarship application for the scholarships offered by many local organizations and individuals. All top scholars must apply to be eligible for the Neely Scholarship money. Apps available in the couns. Office. All applications must be complete when returned to Ms. Kowitz by 2:45 PM March 31, 2010.

Armada Fair Committee Agricultural Scholarship—One male and one female recipient, must have volunteered or exhibited at the fair, (Miss Armada Court included) GPA, financial need NOT a factor. Apps in the counseling office. Due on or before April 15.

Armada AMVETS Auxiliary Post #93—Must be the child or grandchild of a veteran from any branch of the two letters of recommendation, Essay, Transcript, AMVETS membership or DD-21 from the veteran. Due March 31

Greg Goike Memorial Scholarship—students going into a trade or vocational career path. GPA not a factor. Due April 23. Apps in the counseling office

Jeffrey Grant—In memory of Jeffrey King, for AHS seniors who have a minimum 2.5 GPA, have at least **one** of the following: membership in SCADDS or SADD, knowledge of substance abuse personally or through a family member, desire to work in the field of substance abuse or addiction prevention. Apps in the counseling office. Due April 15 in the counseling office.

Michigan Oil and Gas Producers—Must attend a Michigan school, min. 3.0 GPA and financial need. Must be pursuing a degree in an energy related field to eventually work in the oil and gas industry. www.mogpef.org Five \$500 scholarships deadline 4-1-10.

Armada Lioness Scholarship—Must have community service, essay required, not based on GPA. Application in the counseling office—Due April 23

PAL Scholarship—PAL participants only—All PAL participants should apply--Due April 30

Greg Prendergast Memorial Scholarship—any senior who has been a student of Mr. Prendergast's in Middle School—apps in the counseling office Due April 23 in the counseling office

O'Leary-Heide Family Scholarship—Must be attending U of M Ann Arbor campus. Apps in Counseling office deadline—April 19 (extended) Must be neat, well presented application. 500 word essay required.

Ray Township Firefighters—Any senior can apply. Apps in the counseling office. Due on or before April 17 in the counseling office. You do not have to live in Ray Township.

Ray Township Lions Club—Must be a Ray Township resident, overall GPA 2.5+ Due March 30. Apps available in the counseling office.

Ray Township Fire & Rescue Ladies Auxiliary—For any graduating senior. Due April 23 Counseling office

Armada Firefighters and Ladies Auxiliary—Senior pursuing any course of study in healthcare or public service. GPA 3.0+ Due April 14. Apps in the counseling office.

Victoria Hill Memorial Scholarship—For students going into teaching. \$1500 (may be divided) Essay required. 2.5 min. GPA. Apps in the counseling office. Due April 16 in the counseling office

GUSTAFSON GRANT—For seniors who have positively impacted the quality of a life though community service, essay required, career plan must focus on the welfare and enrichment of people or animals. Apps in the counseling office. Due April 14

Lakeshore Striders Running Club—GPA 3.0+ 3 or more seasons running cross country—Due May 15

Metro Detroit Bureau of School Studies—Majoring in education, social work, child psych, medicine or any other child related profession. Must be attending Oakland U, Oakland CC, Wayne State, St. Clair CC. Due June 1. Apps in the counseling office. We have always had a winner!

Southeastern Michigan Association of Chiefs of Police--\$1000 any senior with a criminal justice major—Due May 1 Apps in the counseling office.

Michigan State Troopers Assistance Fund—Min. GPA 3.25 Community Service, leadership ability, include copy of FAFSA. Postmarked on or before April 1. Includes essay.

Michigan Sugar Beet Scholarships—for seniors who have participated in the Youth Sugarbeet Project—App in the counseling office—Due April 21

Society of Polish Engineers—Must be majoring in Engineering or allied sciences and be of Polish descent with a 3.0 GPA or above Postmarked by Friday, April 2. Apps in the counseling office

Rudolph Heino/Sallylou Cloyd--\$2000 for 09 graduates—criteria: member of Michigan Schools and Gov. Credit Union, acceptance in 2or 4 year accredited college, two letters of reference, essay, transcript www.msgcu.org to download apps. Due March 9, 2009

Michigan Society of Professional Engineers—Must be going into an engineering field—www.michiganspe.org—Comprehensive list of scholarship opportunities for engineers.

Skandalaris Family Foundation—Min. GPA 3.5, ACT 27+, involved in school, athletic and community service, must declare acceptance to a college. Scholarships start at \$2000. AHS students have been awarded every year. Start early on the application—Due April 1—Apps in the counseling office or online at www.skandalaris.com

Macomb County Farm Bureau--\$1000 each—must be a resident of Macomb County and a Farm Bureau member at the time of the award. Must be going into an Ag related career. <http://macomb.michfb.com>

Homer J. Van Hollenbeck Foundation—Min. 2.0 GPA demonstrated hardship and financial need—Apps in the counseling office—Received by May 31 to be eligible.

East Macomb Chapter or Retired School Personnel—Need based, three recommendations, GPA and service centered. Must be attending Macomb Com. Col. Apps in the counseling office Due March 30
