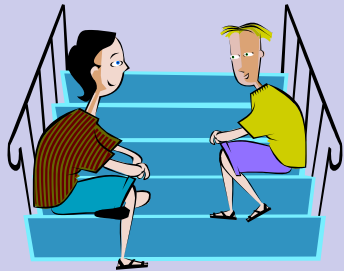

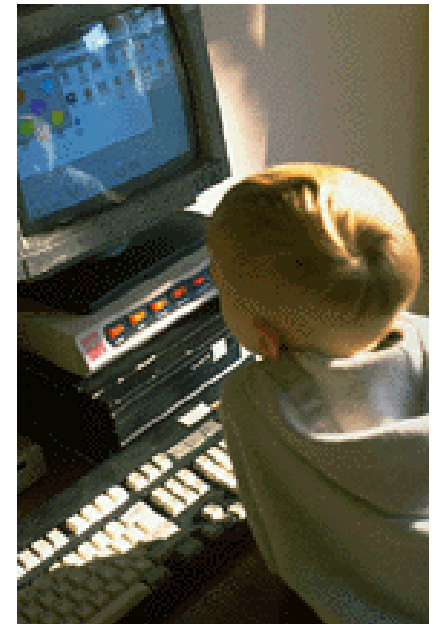

### Welcome to Title I Services!

Based on recent assessment scores, your child is eligible to receive extra support in Reading and/or Math several times a week, using research based programs.

Your child's progress will continue to be regularly assessed and the results of these assessments will be provided to you three times a year.

### Parent Rights and Responsibilities

As a parent, you have the right to refuse these Title I services for your child.

You also have the right to be provided with information on your child's progress on these support programs on a regular basis.

If you have any questions concerning Title I services you, as a parent, may ask for and be provided with additional information on these supplemental programs.

As a parent your support and responsibility will be to make sure that your child attends school regularly.

Your parent support may include working on home work with your child, making sure that your child has a quiet place to work on that homework, and making sure that your child get a good night's sleep and good nutrition.
