
Dear Armada Area School Families,

We are required to add two school days to the calendar. School districts are allowed six snow days and the district used eight snow days this school year. We applied for a state waiver, but were denied. Therefore, June 5<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup> (Monday and Tuesday) are now half school days for students and become exam days for secondary students. June 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> will now be full days of school.

There is pending litigation against the state because they denied numerous waiver requests this school year. If the litigation is successful, we will return to our original calendar dates. However, we have to plan accordingly with our new calendar. We will update families if anything happens with the litigation.
