We want to emphasize that the district takes all forms of bullying and harassment seriously, regardless of where they take place.


Our policies and procedures regarding bullying and harassment align with the highest standards of safety and support for our students. We have a comprehensive framework in place to address such concerns promptly and effectively. Our priority remains the well-being and safety of all our students.

We recognize the significance of collaboration between the school and parents/guardians in fostering a safe and nurturing environment for our students. Your partnership is invaluable in addressing these issues. We encourage an open line of communication between home and school. If parents/guardians and students prefer to remain anonymous in their reporting, we do encourage the use of our anonymous reporting form on the district website and/or through Okay2Say.

Additionally, we encourage all parents/guardians to regularly check their student's social media interactions and conversations. Doing so can provide insight into students' digital experiences and potential concerns they may encounter.
