Dear Armada Area School Families,

Armada Area Schools has placed a no tax-rate increase bond proposal and a sinking fund proposal on the May 2, 2023, ballot. Neither ballot proposal will increase the tax rate on your primary residence (the home in which you live).

Registered voters do not need a reason to vote by absentee ballot. You can request an absentee ballot application from your Clerk's Office or by going to www.michigan.gov/vote and clicking on *Absentee Voting* in the left column. Once your Clerk receives your application, they will mail you an absentee ballot beginning today (March 23).

Registered voters can vote by absentee ballot today through Election Day. You need to update your voter registration if you have changed your name or address since the last time you voted. You can do this at any Secretary of State Office or your local Clerk's Office.
